The meeting discussed Trustee fiduciary responsibilities around risk and governance, and delegation of authority, and to make the concentration table in the IPS clear (suggested by CEO Pena – March IC).

The trustees voted on the motion to revise the concentration table in the IPS as follows:

- · Remove the vehicle limits
- · Add manager limits Public passive no limit, Public active 10%, Private market 5%.
- · Revise private fund concentration 1.5% ex VC, 1% for VC.
- \cdot Changes to the fund of one, sub advisory, fund of fund limit discussion will be taken up separately at a later meeting.
