2. Oral Update by CIO, Prabhu Palani.
3. Presentation of private markets program by Dhinesh Ganapathiappan, Senior Investment Officer and David Aung, Investment Officer.

Senior Investment Officer Dhinesh Ganapathiappan and Investment Officer David Aung gave a comprehensive update on the private markets program of the Police and Fire Plan. The overview included a recap of the objectives, market environment, current portfolio and future of the private markets program. The discussion this year focused largely on distribution and performance. Senior Investment Officer Ganapathiappan covered the buyout, private debt and growth real estate assets. Investment Officer Aung discussed the private real assets and venture capital asset classes.

4. Presentation of manager due diligence by David Aung, Investment Officer.

Investment Officer David Aung gave a presentation on private markets manager due diligence. Mr. Aung stated that due to confidentiality we can not specify the exact investment that was made but can discuss the general guiding principles in choosing a private market investment. He discussed the key elements of private markets strategy. He used a real assets investment as an example to illustrate the due diligence process.

5. Risk overview by Verus Investments.

Mr. Brian Kwan from Verus Investments presented an update on the risk overview of the Police and Fire Plan. He expressed that the total risk of 11.01% under the new Bloomberg model is within the board limit of 12%. Mr. Kwan said there are no observable large active style factor exposure in the portfolio.
