SUBJECT: INTERNAL ORS POLICY REGARDING THE PROCUREMENT AND CONTRACTING

OF GOODS AND SERVICES

DATE: DECEMBER 19, 2024

A few months ago, each of the two Boards approved:

- the Policy Regarding Procurement and Contracting of Goods and Services (the "Policy");
 and
- directed ORS to provide a copy of the Policy to the City Finance Director for comment.

The attached Policy reflects the City's comments, which related only to paragraph 7 (below).

Goods and Services Governed by the City's Policies/Rules (not this Policy)

7) Contracts for goods or non-professional /non-critical plan administrative functionand services procured pursuant to SJMC § 4.12.that (1) exceed the Competitive Procurement Threshold (\$10,000 on December 31, 2023), as defined in SJMC § 4.12.210(a), in total value for the duration A and (2) are not covered under Paragraph 10 and 11 of the contract termthis Policy, shall comply with the City's rules on procurement and contracting pursuant to SJMC §§ 4.12.001 et seq and not this Policy.

The other (minor) proposed changes are below.

- Refer to the Joint Ad Hoc Committee as "JAHC", rather than "JAC", in paragraph 13.
- Decrease the review frequency to 5 years (from 2) in paragraph 53.
- Document (under "Policy Review and History") the fact that the Boards directed ORS to share a draft of this Policy with the City for its review and comments on Aug 15, 2024 (Federated) and Sep 5, 2024 (P&F) in paragraphs 54 and 55 respectively.

Reed Smith has reviewed these changes.
