### 4. New Business

**a.** Discussion and action on factual findings for use of California Assembly Bill 361's abbreviated teleconferencing procedures.

Counsel Chin introduced and spoke to the item. Ms. Chin explained the contents of the memo submitted to the Committee regarding evidentiary support for the Committee's consideration of factual findings necessary for election to adopt AB 361's abbreviated teleconferencing procedures, which included:

- (1) Governor's proclamation on the continued state of emergency due to the ongoing COVID 19 pandemic; and
- (2) the City Council's recent resolution that continued to impose recommend and impose social distancing in City facilities.

A motion was made to adopt the Committee's factual findings under AB361 to allow the Committee to continue meeting virtually for the next 30 days.

### 5. JOINT AUDIT COMMITTEE

**a.** Approval of the Minutes of the February 17, 2022 Joint Audit Committee meeting for the Federated City Employee's Retirement System and the Police and Fire Retirement Plan.

A motion was made to approve the Minutes of the February 17, 2022 Joint Audit Committee meeting.

**b.** Update on the City Auditor's Recommendation to the Office of Retirement Services.

CEO Peña updated the Board that there are no changes to the City Auditor's Recommendation.

**c.** Discussion and action on FY 21-22 Office of Retirement Services Plans Audit Plan by Grant Thornton.

John Caldwell and Svetlana Polyakova from Grant Thornton spoke to the item and answered questions from the Committee. They discussed the role of the Auditor, responsibilities of the Audit Committee and management, the timeline, deliverables, materiality, areas of focus, risk assessment overview, considerations of COVID-19 and internal control matters. CEO Peña thanked Mr. Caldwell and Ms. Polyakova.

A motion was made to approve the FY 21-22 Office of Retirement Services Plans Audit Plan by Grant Thornton.

Approved by Federated. (M.S.C. Jennings/Avasthy 3-0-0). The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Approved by Police & Fire. (M.S.C. Lee/Ganapati 3-0-0). The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

**d.** Presentation of the Reconciliation of Contributions Audit by Internal Auditor, Houman Boussina.

Houman Boussina, Senior Internal Auditor, presented the Reconciliation of Contributions Audit and answered questions from the Committee. The purpose of the Audit was to determine if the Office of Retirement Services (ORS) accurately recorded pension plan contributions paid by the City of San José and eligible City employees (i.e., pension plan members) in the City's financial records and the ORS's PensionGold system. The audit scope included an assessment of ORS Accounting policies and procedures to ensure the timeliness, accuracy, and completeness of City contributions recorded.
