1. NEW BUSINESS

a. Discussion and action on factual findings for use of California Assembly Bill 361's abbreviated teleconferencing procedures.

Counsel Chin spoke to the item and explained the contents of the memo submitted to the Committee regarding evidentiary support for the Committee's consideration of factual findings necessary for election to adopt AB 361's abbreviated teleconferencing procedures, which included:

- (1) Governor's proclamation on the continued state of emergency due to the ongoing COVID 19 pandemic; and
- (2) the City Council's recent resolution that continued to impose and recommend social distancing in City facilities.

A motion was made to adopt these as the Committee's factual findings under AB361 to allow the Committee to continue meeting virtually for the next 30 days.
