 - **a. Robert Foster**, Police Officer, Police Department, Request for a Service-Connected Disability

Retirement, effective November 5, 2020; 24.05* years of service.

Stacee Fischer, Benefits Analyst read the case information into the record. The applicant was present and represented by Attorney Thomas Boyle. Dr. Tierman reported all doctors concur that there is a work-related contribution to the applicant's present pain and impairment. Counsel Richeda recommended the Board grant a Service-Connected Disability retirement. Trustee Lanza agreed. The Committee thanked Mr. Foster for his service.

A motion was made to recommend approval to the Board for a Service-Connected Disability Retirement. This item will be placed on the Consent Calendar of the November 5, 2020 Police and Fire Board agenda.
