THE LEVINE ACT

The Levine Act requires a Party in a Proceeding before the City of San José that involves any action related to their contract, license, permit, or use entitlement to disclose any campaign contributions to City elected or appointed officials totaling more than \$500 within the 12 months prior to the City decision. A Participant to a Proceeding may voluntarily report a campaign contribution on the form located on the Levine Act webpage.

2. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Oral Update from CIO, Jay Kwon.

CIO Kwon introduced the agenda items for today's meeting.

- b. Overview of public equity by Christina Wang, Investment Officer.

Investment Officer Christina Wang and Investment Analyst Harrison Pearce gave a comprehensive overview of the Federated Plan's public equity strategy. The overview included a review of the objectives, manager selection process, portfolio construction and a snapshot of the fee schedules. Christina also highlighted the watch list managers. They answered questions from the Committee.

- c. Discussion and action on fiscal year 2026-2027 private markets pacing plan by Dhinesh Ganapathiappan, Senior Investment Officer.

Senior Investment Officer Dhinesh Ganapathiappan and Investment Officer David Aung presented the private markets pacing plan for the upcoming fiscal year 2026-2027. Dhinesh reminded the Committee that the pacing plan is a guide for how we can get to our strategic asset allocation targets. They presented the fiscal year end review, current positioning and proposed commitments in the different private market assets for the upcoming fiscal year.

A motion was made to approve and to recommend the pacing plan to the full Board at the next Board meeting.

- d. Discussion and action on strategic asset allocation by Meketa Investments.

Laura Wirick, Meketa Investment Group, presented the annual discussion on capital market assumptions and the strategic asset allocation. Using market data, Meketa put together some models of the Plan's current asset allocation and a few alternatives. The lower interest rates and higher equity valuations have lower expectations for returns across different asset classes. After a thorough discussion, the Committee decided to recommend no changes to the current asset allocation.

A motion was made to present the current Meketa asset allocation to the full Board at the next Board meeting.
