

**August 7, 2025 Police and Fire Board Meeting Report Out of Closed Session Item I.B: Conference with Legal Counsel – Anticipated Litigation Pursuant to Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(4): One Case.**

**October 2, 2025 Police and Fire Board Meeting Report Out of Closed Session Item I.B: Conference with Legal Counsel – Pending Litigation Pursuant to Government Code Section 54956.9(a). *San Jose Police and Fire Department Retirement Plan v. Ok Hui Moyland, et al.*, Alameda County Superior Court, Case No. 25CV137712.**

On August 7, 2025, the Board of Administration (“Board”) for the Police and Fire Department Retirement Plan (“Plan”) authorized its legal counsel to file a Complaint in Interpleader (“Complaint”) pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 386(b) to determine which of Ok Hui Moyland’s children was authorized to act as her attorney-in-fact for Plan benefit distributions. Ok Hui Moyland is the surviving spouse beneficiary of deceased Plan member Keith John Moyland.

On August 14, 2025, the Board’s legal counsel filed the Complaint in Alameda County Superior Court on behalf of the Plan.

At its October 2, 2025 meeting in Closed Session, the Board granted its legal counsel authorization to dismiss the Board’s Complaint filed in the above referenced case upon receipt of a Court Order specifying who was the attorney-in-fact for Ok Hui Moyland with regard to her Plan benefits.

On January 23, 2026, the Court entered a Stipulation and Order fully resolving the power of attorney issues underlying the Complaint. On March 9, 2026, the Court entered a further Order directing that the interpleaded funds be released for payment.

On March 17, 2026, the Plan filed a Request for Dismissal of the above-referenced case, and the Court dismissed the Complaint in Interpleader without prejudice that same day.
