Revised FY2026-2027 Audit Plan Projects

- **Investment Management Process** - investment valuation and financial reporting, accuracy of Net Asset Valuation, completeness and accuracy of data from investment managers.
- **Contribution Returns Process** - member refund processing and reporting, appropriate authorization, accuracy, timeliness, fraud prevention, tax treatment, accounting, reconciliations, and timely resolution of discrepancies.

Revised FY2026-2027 Audit Plan Projects continued

- **Benefits Disbursements Process** - benefit payment processing and reporting, eligibility verification, calculation accuracy, payment execution, banking information, tax treatment, fraud prevention, financial recording, audit trails, reconciliations, and timely resolution of discrepancies.
- **IT Governance & Management** - IT governance and management processes, IT strategy alignment, investment, and resources with organizational objectives, establish appropriate roles, responsibilities, policies and oversight; and support effective risk management, prioritization, decision-making, accountability and escalation of significant IT matters.
